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| Pass/Fail | Applicant demonstrates an understanding of and adherence to one or a combination of the four foundational skills strategies that are the focus of this grant opportunity. |
| Program Design (60 points) | |
| 20 points | Current Program Alignment with Model(s): Program to be enhanced by mini-grant aligns with one or a combination of some of the four foundational skills strategies. |
| 30 points | Mini-Grant Role and Intended Impact: Applicant is clear as to how the mini-grant will strengthen the program's adherence to the essential elements of their chosen strategy(s). |
| 10 points | Outcomes: Planned outcomes are significant and realistic. |
| Budget and Tracking (20 points) | |
| 10 points | Budget: Program's budget is realistic for the proposed scope of work. |
| 10 points | Data: Proposal demonstrates a commitment and capacity to data collection and program evaluation |
| Organizational Background (20 points) | |
| 10 points | Experience: Organization either has a track record of creating opportunity for Detroiters or has done so in comparable communities. |
| 10 Points | System Contribution: Fills a gap in the current system and/or has the potential to scale up |
